Motor Vehicle Expenses

If you own **one** rental property you must meet all of the following conditions:

-you receive income from only one rental property that is in the general area where you live; -you personally do part, or all, of the necessary **repairs and maintenance** on the property; and -you have motor vehicle expenses to transport tools and materials to the rental property.

You cannot deduct motor vehicle expenses you incur to collect rents.

If you own **two** or more rental properties, in addition to the repairs and maintenance mileage above you can deduct reasonable motor vehicle expenses you incur to do any of the following:

-collect rents;

-supervise repairs; and

-generally manage the properties

This applies whether your rental properties are located in or outside the general area where you live. However, your rental properties have to be located in at least two different sites away from your principal residence.
